## Quarter Two:

All assessments will be documented and shared with staff by October 23, 2020 All assessments will be communicated to students/families the week of November 2, 2020

- Landscape painting
- Still Life painting
- Mixed Media Synthesis with Color for Effect
- Memorial Art Gallery Field Experience
- Virtual Exhibit
- Peer Critique -critique/comment on another student's work in Google portfolios.
- Written Reflection
- Complete Portfolio

Students will be evaluated and graded on all course assessments. In order to receive course credit, the identified required course assessments must be completed and demonstrate an acceptable level of proficiency. If a student does not complete any one of the required course assessments, he/she will receive an incomplete (INC) as a grade.
